Net Generation of Subsidiary Power Plants in the First Two Months of 2017 Increased by 1.5%

China Resources Power Holdings Company Limited (“CR Power”, stock code: 0836) today announced that total net generation of subsidiary power plants in February 2017 increased by 10.3% to 11,746,258MWh from 10,645,853MWh for the same period of 2016. Total net generation of subsidiary power plants for the first two months of 2017 increased by 1.5% to 24,924,510MWh compared to 24,552,025MWh for the same period last year.

On a same plant basis, total net generation of subsidiary coal-fired power plants for the first two months of 2017 decreased by 4.0% compared to the same period of 2016. Power plants located in Guangdong, Hubei and Hebei recorded 52.1%, 4.8% and 3.3% increases year on year, respectively. Power plants located in Henan, Jiangsu and Other provinces recorded 35.4%, 0.9% and 6.6% decreases year on year, respectively.
